Portfolio Deadline: December 20th

Junior/Senior DPA (District Project Achievement) is a public speaking competition where 4-H'ers pick a project area of interest, do project work in that area throughout the year then research a specific topic, write a presentation, and present it to a judging panel.

In addition to the presentation, a portfolio must be submitted to demonstrate to others what you have done in your project area, leadership and citizenship. It is a COLLECTION, SELECTION, and REFLECTION of your past year (Jan 2024 - Dec 2024). Portfolios, while following a set of guidelines, tell the story of your achievements and growth characterized by a strong vision of content, skills and learning.

It's not too late to be working on your portfolio. One of the most important steps is to be active in 4-H! Anytime there is a 4-H event- especially if it is a community service or leadership opportunity, you need to make plans to attend. Always take pictures! If you give leadership in your Project Area, have someone take a picture of you. You will have to include pictures in your portfolio. Attend our monthly Portfolio Workshops or set up an appointment to come in and work on your portfolio at the 4-H office.

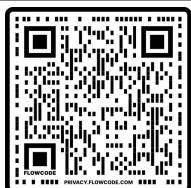
